

Instruction to Print the GLAST Race (card game)

A. For file name “*gracecard1*”:

1. The first card image is the “common” back of each card on this file (red and green, with the GLAST satellite in the middle). It is not necessary to print, and may even be tricky if you don’t have a printer set up for this kind of printing.
